Shaton Berry - National PTA Member Representative to the Board of Directors



Shaton Berry currently serves as a member on the National PTA board of directors, and as a member of the National PTA leadership committee. She has been a PTA volunteer for over 16 years, most notably serving as chair for the National PTA Nominating and Leadership Recruitment Committee from 2017-2018, and serving as president of Michigan PTA from 2011-2013. Berry is also a certified Training Capacity Building Initiative (TCBI) and grassroots advocacy trainer through National PTA.

Berry truly believes in the mission and purposes of PTA and wants to ensure its place as a world class association for families. Her passion stems from her personal experience with unique family structures. She does

not have any biological children; she raised her two younger brothers, Anthony and Deontae.

Professionally, Berry has worked for the Federal government as a public servant for over 19 years. She also serves as the Chief Operating Officer of Purposeful YOUth Detroit, a non-profit organization that focuses on the empowerment and mentoring of girls ages six to 18.

This is the place where your unit has the opportunity to directly affect the business of the state PTA, energize your leaders, hear top keynote speakers, and obtain excellent training.

Convention is open to all PTA members in the state. We suggest that unit and council officers and board members, both incoming and outgoing, attend convention.

Who should pay for delegates to attend?

<u>Admissions</u>

- The Kansas PTA Convention shall be open to all members of the Kansas PTA. All delegates must be registered and paid the Convention registration fee to participate in the General meetings, Exhibitor Expo Hall and workshops.
- No delegate shall represent more than one PTA unit.
- Delegates are requested to be logged in at the opening of each session and to remain until the close of each session.
- Each member is responsible for his or her audio and internet connections. No action shall be invalidated on the grounds that the loss of, or poor quality of, a member's individual connection prevented participation in the meeting.
- The Chair or facilitator may cause or direct the temporary disconnection or muting of an attendee's connection if it is causing undue interference with the meeting.

Speaking and Voting Procedures

- 1. The privilege of making motions and nominations, debating and voting shall be limited to presidents or alternates of councils and units: to the accredited representatives from each local PTA and to the Kansas PTA Board of Managers.
- 2 A delegate wishing to speak from the floor shall "raise their hand" by sending the signal to speak as indicated on the internet meeting service and wait to be recognized by the chair before speaking.
- 3. When recognized, delegates shall give their full name and name of local unit, council or State Board of Managers and their virtual ticket number. They shall specify if they are speaking for or against a motion, if they have an amendment to the motion, or if they have a question for the motion that is on the floor.
- 4. Delegates wishing to amend a motion that is currently "on the floor" or make a main motion must send a written motion through the Chat feature, with the delegate's name, PTA name, their position in that PTA, and the amendment/motion being made prior to making the amendment/motion.
- 5. The president shall recognize delegates in the order their "hands were raised". When speaking either in favor of or against a motion, the delegate shall follow the instructions in number three (#3) above, and state: "I speak in favor of this motion" or "I speak against this motion" and then explain their reason why or rationale.
- 6. A delegate may speak up to two (2) minutes at a time on a given subject and shall be permitted to speak for a s second time only when all other delegates wishing to speak for the first time on the subject have had a chance to do so. No delegate may speak more than twice on the same subject on the same day.
- 7. A motion for the previous question will not be considered unless at least one (1) speaker has had an opportunity to be heard on each side of the pending question.
- 8. All items of business shall be on the floor for debate for no more than twenty (20) minutes, inclusive of all points of order and points of information. The clock will run uninterrupted unless ordered by the Chair. A delegate may make a motion to extend debate for a specific amount of time. This motion requires a second, is amendable, is not debatable, and requires a two-thirds (2/3) in favor to pass.
- 9. A proposed resolution which has been rejected by the Resolutions Committee and resolutions for which notice has not been given shall require a two-thirds (2/3) vote to permit introduction to the convention body. The submitting party shall provide a copy for each delegate.

General Rules

- Announcements must have the approval of the Kansas PTA President.
- The President shall determine and adjust the agenda as required for the smooth operation of the assembly. The published agenda is for guidance only and shall not be considered either general or special orders.
- There shall be a timekeeper appointed by the chair. The speaker shall conform to the ruling of the timekeeper.
- During all voting, no delegate will be allowed to enter the meeting when a vote is being taken until the voting is complete and the Chair announces the results of the vote.





Kansas PTA 2022 Virtual Convention Rules

Convention Rules Continued....

- The meeting facilitator, or any assistants appointed by him for this purpose, shall share a screen during voting that displays the immediately pending question and other relevant pending questions (such as main motion, or the pertinent part of the main motion, when an amendment to it is immediately pending).
- Votes shall be taken by a virtual voting feature of the platform, unless a different method is ordered by the Board or required by the rules.
- Votes shall be taken electronically, as follows: The Facilitator shall post the question on the online survey tool, an the chair shall then alert the voting members that the polls are open, providing any additions, information that members need to cast their votes online. The polls shall be closed not less than one (1) minute after they have been opened by the chair.
- The Parliamentarian shall interpret the rules and in case of controversy shall advise the Chair, who shall make the final decision. The Parliamentarian shall advise the Chair on points of procedure and on request from the Chair, shall explain such points to the delegates.
- Routine business may be conducted by unanimous consent. Any objections must be made audibly and in the chat by typing "(Name) objects."
- The presence of a quorum shall be determined by the chair at the beginning of that meeting by referencing the online list of credentialed delegates. Thereafter, the continued presence of a quorum shall be assumed, unless any member demands a quorum count by audible roll count. Such a demand may be made following any vote for which the announced totals add to less than a quorum.
- Consent for the use of photographs and/or video taken at this convention is granted by attendee's presence
- Members are prohibited from recording and live streaming the meetings and workshops.

SOME THINGS TO CONSIDER

Read all of the rules and attend the meeting using a device with a strong internet connection in a quiet place.

- 1. Organize your thoughts so you can make your remarks within the time limit.
- 2. If you offer a primary or secondary amendment or a motion of higher rank, please type into the Chat. Tip..lt might save time if your amendment is already typed in "Word" on your computer, then you can quickly copy and paste into the Chat when directed to do so by the Chair.
- 3. If you want to speak, raise your hand (using the "raise hand" feature). Type into the Chat feature.
- 4. Please be on time, and stay until the business is completed if you are a voting delegate.
- 5. Make sure all updates to your Zoom app have been installed. Enhancements have been made around security and added features. Installing the latest updates will help ensure you have the very best experience in the virtual convention.
- 6. Be sure to take any tutorials about the Virtual Convention prior to the convention, so that your experience is as smooth and stress free as can be.
- 7. If your video feed stutters or freezes, turn off your video and turn it back on, this should help.

CHAT INSTRUCTIONS

The Chat should be used to:

- Type a motion or amendment to a motion when the Chair asks for it.
- Ask a question related to the proceedings (request for information or parliamentary inquiry).

Please do not use the Chat as a tool for chatting with others. This is distracting to other delegates.

The Chat should be used for any other meeting/workshop related questions.


