Teacher, Principal, Para-Educator, Administrator or Superintendent

Kansas PTA recognizes and honors an outstanding educator each year at the Annual State PTA Convention. An outstanding educator is defined as an educator making an outstanding, significant and unique contribution in the field of education benefiting children and youth. 'Educator' applies to teachers, principals, para-educators, administrators or superintendents. Any PTA member, unit, council or region may submit nominations. The nominee must be a member of a local PTA unit and, if a teacher or principal, must be from a school that is affiliated with a PTA Unit and in 'Good Standing'.

The honoree may be asked to attend the Kansas PTA Convention to receive this award. If applicable, accommodations will be provided.

Letters of recommendation from others in the school, the PTA, or the community may be included. Please include a photo of the nominee.

- 2) What is the educator's involvement with the PTA and commitment to PTA objectives?
- 3) Link between educator's professional work and the community.
- 4) Additional areas the educator may be considered 'outstanding' or 'unique'.
