Kansas PTA recognizes and honors an outstanding student in Kansas each year at the Annual State PTA Convention. This award focuses on the accomplishments of the student and not necessarily on their service to PTA. Any student K-12 may qualify. The nominee must be from a school that is affiliated with a PTA Unit and in 'Good Standing'.

The honoree (and chaperone) may be asked to attend the Kansas PTA Convention to receive this award. If applicable, accommodations will be provided.

Letters of recommendation from others in the school, the PTA, or the community may be included. Please include a photo of the nominee.

- Criteria: Nominee should be outstanding in more than one area below:
 - 1) Outstanding leadership in school (inspiring, motivational, influential)
 - 2) Overcome odds to accomplish education
 - 3) Started and led an organization in the school and/or community
 - 4) Accomplishment over and above usual activity of others their age
 - 5) Successful academics (not necessarily a straight "A" student)
